WHAT MIDDLE SCHOOLERS NEED MORE THAN ANYTHING ELSE IS FOR PARENTS AND THE CHURCH TO AFFIRM THEIR PERSONAL JOURNEY IN A SEASON OF RAPID CHANGE.

For middle schoolers, having people to belong to matters. A LOT. *Fun* matters. We know that as a parent, you are trying hard to help your middle schooler begin to discover his or her identity as one made uniquely by God for a purpose (*You may also be trying hard to get him or her to just shower on a regular basis. We get it.*)

Sometimes, your youth will hear the truth you are trying to instill in them when that truth is echoed by another adult that they love and trust. That's where what we do every week comes in to help you lead your middle schooler on their journey of faith.

SUNDAYS

EVERY SUNDAY (starting August 6, 2017) AT 9:30 A.M., MIDDLE SCHOOL MEETS IN THE YOUTH CENTER.

We worship together, have some fun, and engage God's Word in a way that is relevant for the middle school phase of life. From there, we break into small groups (*aka the most important part of Youth at the Crossing*), where your youth gets to process and share life with adults who are committed to walking with them. Our 5th and 6th graders will head to the gym from 10:15-10:45 a.m. to play some epic games, while the 7th and 8th graders have a little extra time to hang in the Youth Center.

EVERY SUNDAY AT 11 A.M., YOUR MIDDLE SCHOOLER HAS TWO AWESOME OPTIONS:

1) Go to big church (aka corporate worship). They can sit with their friends in the front row, or with your family. One thing we know for sure is that youth who have felt a part of the larger church—not just the youth group—are less likely to walk away from faith after they graduate. So, making worship a priority is a BIG deal.

2) Be a Kids! Influencer! No matter how old we are, we need people who are older than us pouring into us (like small group leaders), people our age to journey with us (like friends in small group), and people younger than us who we are investing in. When your youth signs up to serve twice a month with Kids!, they grow as they get to put their faith into action and kids benefit from their loving example. Everyone wins!

MIDWEEK

EVERY WEDNESDAY, MIDDLE SCHOOL MEETS AT THE CHURCH FOR A TIME OF LARGE GROUP GAMES AND GRADE SPECIFIC BREAKOUTS.

Because we believe that every phase of life is incredibly important, we want middle schoolers to have time to think more about the phase of life that they're in, which looks a little different for each grade. Because of that, Middle School Midweek gives space to ask questions and be with others who may have those same questions.

As a parent, you may be frustrated at times with their quest for independence. That's why we want to connect you with small group leaders who are committed to journeying with your high schooler, and may get a little different glimpse into your high schooler's world.

Together, we can better love, support, influence and prepare to launch your youth toward a lifelong journey with Jesus. Here's what we do every week with that goal in mind...

SUNDAYS

EVERY SUNDAY (starting August 6, 2017) AT 11 A.M., HIGH SCHOOL MEETS IN THE YOUTH CENTER.

Because small groups are so important to faith development in this phase of life, we will spend the majority of our time together every week creating space for high schoolers to ask questions, grow deeper, explore their faith, and connect relationally in the context of a small group. We will also have time to worship, have fun, and discover biblical truth in a large group setting.

EVERY SUNDAY AT 9:30 A.M., YOUR HIGH SCHOOLER HAS TWO AWESOME OPTIONS:

MIDWEEK

BECAUSE WE WANT EVERY HIGH SCHOOLER TO BE EMPOWERED TO SERVE FROM THEIR PASSIONS AND GIFTS ON A REGULAR BASIS, WE ARE NOW ENCOURAGING OUR HIGH SCHOOLERS TO JOIN A SERVE GROUP THROUGHOUT THE WEEK.

Each group will receive a calendar of dates when they sign up in August, and will commit to serve for (at least) one semester. Some groups will serve weekly, others about twice a month. Serve Groups have the powerful impact of Work Camps all throughout the year. High Schoolers can sign up with friends, with their small group, or on their own based on their passions.

9th Grade // During the Fall 2017 semester, our 9th graders will meet with their small groups on Wednesday nights for the Centered Experience. Centered is a formative discipleship experience, and will help our 9th graders examine the foundations of faith, discover their gifts and prepare for future service (If you are a parent of a 9th grader, we encourage you to consider joining an adult Centered group this fall as a way to journey with your youth).

10th-12th Grade // Our Serve Group opportunities for 10th-12th graders will be ready for youth to sign up starting in August. Some likely examples include serving with Shepherd Community Center, Nora Elementary, and Pure Religion. On campus, there will be opportunities to serve with Kids, worship, and even help lead a middle school small group on Wednesday nights (11th & 12th grade only).
